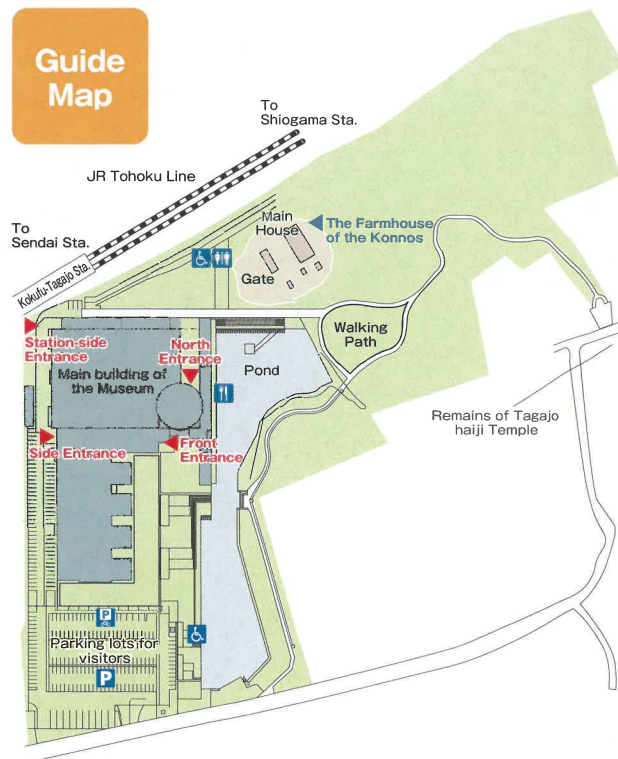


Guide Map

Built in the middle of the Edo period, originally located in Kitakami-Machi, Ishinomaki City in Miyagi Pref., and removed to this museum.

You can get a glimpse of farmer's lifestyle in those days.

Open 9:30 a.m.-5:00 p.m. (entry closes at 4:30)

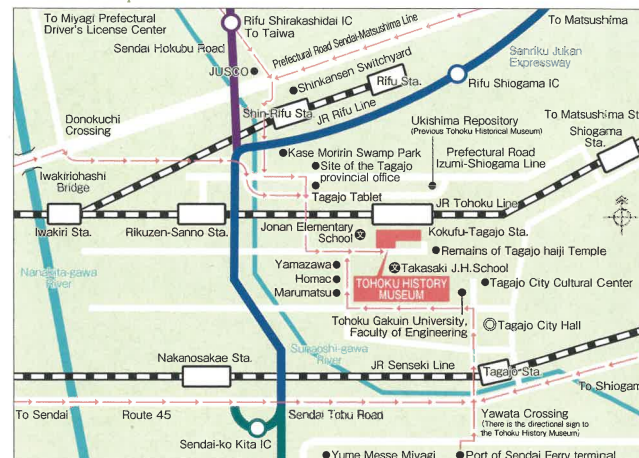

- **Via JR Tohoku Line**
Approximately 14 minutes from Sendai Station to Kokufu-Tagajo Station.
About 1 minute on foot.
- **Via JR Senseki Line**
Approximately 21 minutes from Sendai Station to Tagajo Station.
About 10 minutes by taxi or 25 minutes on foot.
- **By car**
 - From Sendai Tobu Road
Approximately 10 minutes from Sendai-ko Kita Interchange to the museum.

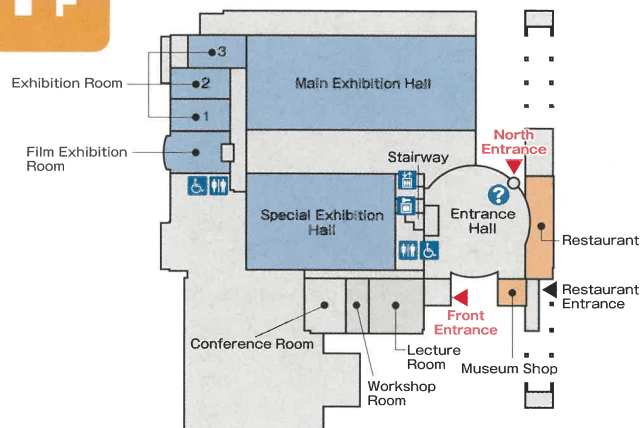

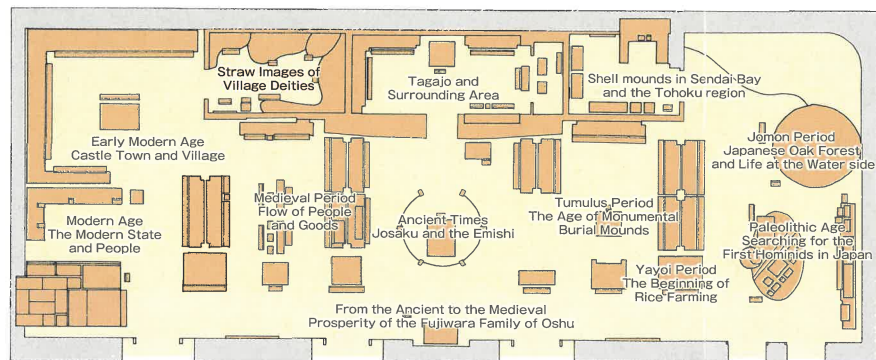

Main Exhibition Hall

Exhibits on nine periods ranging from the Paleolithic Age to the Modern Age display the history of Tohoku. An advanced exhibition is arranged according to three characteristic features of Tohoku.



Special Exhibition Hall

Special or planned exhibits are held a few times a year.



Film Exhibition Room

This room shows films on the festivals and folk art of the Tohoku district. Screenings are twice a day at 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.



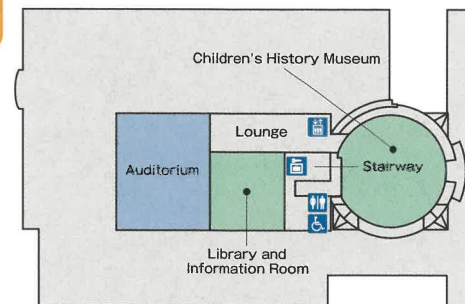
Exhibition Rooms 1-3
